

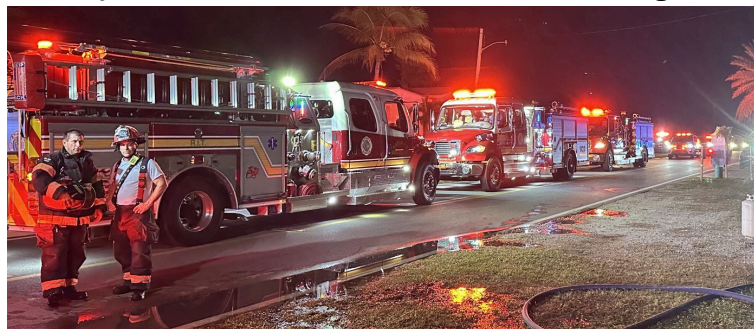


DECEMBER 2024

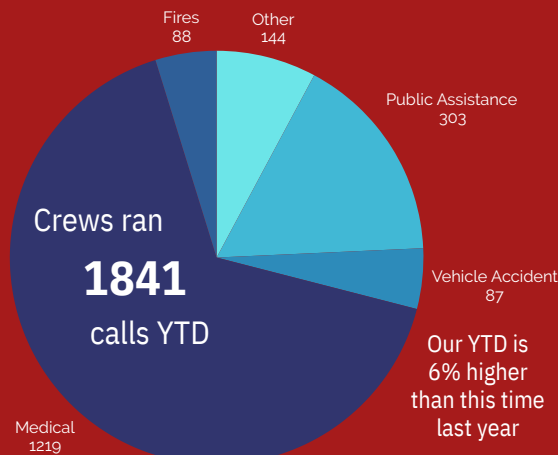
Congratulations to Bryant Cole on his promotion to engineer!
